**OLD BUSINESS**

**Tracking System – Conference DVD**

**Workforce Development**

- Discussion continued on planning ideas for the next workforce development group – nurses who are currently in the workforce
- A draft modification of the survey monkey questions used for SW was presented and discussed – suggestions were made and will be incorporated
- There was discussion on how to best gather input from nurses - GNA does not share their e-mail list although they do sell their mailing list

- It was decided that a random sample of nurses would be surveyed via survey monkey and we'd try and access the nurses for the sample as follows:
  - 3 Hospitals – Emory, Grady and Piedmont
    - Eve will talk to nursing services at Emory and Grady and see if they'll let us use their nursing data base and Cathy will talk to someone she knows at Piedmont
  - 3 large local University Schools of Nursing – Emory – Georgia State and Kennesaw – asking to access their metro Atlanta nursing alumni
  - We will also check with Rebecca Dillard to see if she has any list-serve groups of nurses that we could send the survey

### **ARGEC Update**

- ARGEC'S annual performance report goes in on August 31 and includes the demographic data and head count of participants from all of the various ARGEC educational activities. Rebecca offered her thanks to the AACAMH and members for their support this year. Programs through AACAMH/ARC really helped boost numbers and round out their program nicely.
- HRSA is still trying to determine what demographic information they want ARGEC to collect on participants in ARGEC programs for the 2011-2012 year. In 2010-2011, they used the scantron forms which presented some challenges so they plan to switch over to a simpler format that is more easily emailed and doesn't require a #2 pencil.
